Description of Fellowship: The Pain Management Services at Stanford University Hospital include innovative programs in clinical and basic science research in acute and chronic pain. The ACGME-approved program focuses on pharmacokinetic and pharmacodynamic considerations of systemic and spinal opiates, as well as state-of-the-art treatment of neuropathic pain syndromes, including the use of implantable dorsal column stimulators (placed by anesthesia faculty and staff). The multi-disciplinary treatment of both acute and chronic pain is emphasized.

Fellowships of 12 and 24 months duration are offered. The fellow will participate in the clinical operation of a multidisciplinary outpatient service, as well as an active inpatient, chronic and acute pain management service.

Ongoing clinical research with novel analgesics, individualized kinetic dynamic modeling and clinical outcome analgesia will be integrated within the fellowship. Didactic programs in clinical management and research training are scheduled twice weekly.
