I am the current Director of District 11 for the California Society of Anesthesiologists, and I am now running for reelection. I am an Associate Clinical Professor in the Department of Anesthesiology at UCLA where I run the Acute Pain Service and serve as the Chief of Orthopedic Anesthesia.
