Since 2008 Dr. Moore has served as the Vice Speaker of the House of Delegates for the California Society of Anesthesiologists. He has been on the CSA Board of Directors for five years and was previously the Director of CSA District 11, serving West Los Angeles County. For the CSA he is currently the Chair of the Committee on Bylaws and a member of the Committee on Finance and Administration, the Legislative and Practice Affairs Division, and the Committee on Leadership Development and Nominations. Dr. Moore has chaired CSA task forces on the Annual Meeting and the House of Delegates. He is a Delegate to the American Society of Anesthesiologists and in the ASA also serves on the Committee on Regional Anesthesia as well as the Committee on Annual Meeting Sites.

Dr. Moore is an Associate Clinical Professor of Anesthesiology and the Administrative Director of the Preanesthesia Evaluation Service at UCLA. His clinical specialty is regional anesthesia, on which he has published and lectured extensively. He completed residency at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston followed by clinical and research fellowships in regional anesthesia at Virginia Mason Medical Center in Seattle.
