Dr. Barbara Van de Wiele is Clinical Professor of Anesthesiology at the David Geffen School of Medicine at the University of California at Los Angeles. She is Director of the Division of Neurosurgical Anesthesiology and Vice Chair for Clinical Affairs of the Department of Anesthesiology. Her clinical interests focus on the anesthetic management of adult and pediatric patients undergoing neurosurgery.

Dr. Van de Wiele received her undergraduate degree from Smith College and her M.D. from the College of Physicians and Surgeons at Columbia University. She joined the faculty of the UCLA Department of Anesthesiology in 1989 after completing residency and anesthesiology fellowships at that institution. Her primary educational activity is the clinical teaching of anesthesiology residents and fellows. She lectures on neurosurgical anesthesiology topics locally, nationally, and internationally. She participates in the activities of a charitable health care organization, Global Neuro Rescue, and in the last two years has provided volunteer anesthesia care for children undergoing neurosurgical procedures in Latin America, China and Eastern Europe.

Dr. Van de Wiele has been actively involved with the Educational Programs Division of the California Society of Anesthesiologists since 1998. Her goal as a member of the Board is to represent the Educational Programs Division in its efforts to provide excellent and innovative continuing medical education opportunities to members of the California Society of Anesthesiologists.
