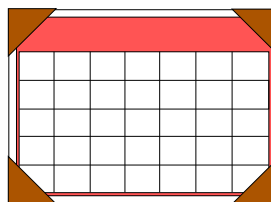

The photograph that appears on the cover of the 2005 *CSA Bulletin* is one of an old dead bristlecone pine tree that the photographer, Gordon Haddow, M.D., discovered while traveling in the White Mountains, east of Bishop, California. The altitude there is approximately 10,000 feet and the picture was taken in late September 2002 around 8:00 a.m. Dr. Haddow used a Nikon F100 camera with a Nikkor 18-35 mm zoom lens at 18 mm and a red filter. This photographic masterpiece was awarded the “Best of Show” at the 2003 ASA Art Exhibit.
