Description of Fellowship: The Department of Anesthesia at Stanford University Medical Center offers a one year ACGME-approved fellowship in pediatric anesthesia.

We are responsible for the anesthesia for approximately 5000 cases per year in every surgical subspecialty, including organ transplantation. We have eight pediatric anesthesiologists on staff, two fellows, and four residents assigned to our service. All division attendings have completed subspecialty training in pediatric anesthesia and many are certified in pediatrics and pediatric critical care medicine. The fellows on our service will rotate through several assignments during the course of the fellowship year.

The fellowship position is open to candidates who have successfully completed residency training in anesthesiology at an accredited training program and who are board eligible or certified in anesthesiology.
