Description of Fellowship: Focus on developing improved methods to measure pain in humans, to assess the efficacy of analgesic interventions with greater accuracy and to allow predicting the clinical usefulness of new analgesic compounds/interventions at an early stage of drug/interventional development. Emphasis lies on psychophysical approaches to measure pain and on various experimental pain models used in humans. Data evaluation and analysis is based on concepts used in clinical pharmacology.
